

## **Rehabilitation of Wied il-Għasel by Ambjent Malta (Valley Management) in collaboration with the Ministry for Transport, Infrastructure and Capital Projects (MTIP)**

The first phase of the RainWiiN project (RainWater Integrated Infrastructure Network) which consists of a proposal for a planning framework with action plans for the establishment of an integrated infrastructure network for rainwater management in five rainwater catchments in Malta and Gozo was launched. The project is led by Ambjent Malta (Valley Management) with the Ministry for Transport, Infrastructure and Capital Projects (MTIP) as a beneficiary partner, while it will be co-financed through the EU's Cohesion Fund.

The first component of this project involves the development of the planning framework. The second component concerns the implementation of a pilot project in Wied il-Għasel whereby this valley will be restored and will be able to store about 45,000 cubic meters of water. Also, over one thousand and two hundred indigenous trees and shrubs will be planted in this valley.
